However, a combination of changes in the industry environment and an aging grain facility have recently made it more difficult for the Company to achieve the high performance standards it has set for itself as articulated in its Vision and Mission Statements.

This new grain elevator upgrade project seeks to address the safety concerns and long customer waiting times associated with the current state of the Company's handling facility. Additionally, several areas in which efficiency can be improved through the completion of the project have been identified.

The \$4,000,000 elevator upgrade project consists of eight main subprojects:

- 1) Extension of shipping leg to elevator head
- 2) Primary distributor replacement
- 3) Addition of probing station
- 4) Expansion of grading room and office
- 5) Leg four movement to allow access to bulk weigher
- 6) Extension of driveway shed
- 7) Reconfiguration to allow for shipment from pre-weighed bins
- 8) Addition to driveway drag to reach shipping leg from driveway two

The project will commence immediately and is expected to be completed the spring of 2012. At this time, we ask for your patience as there may be delays in and around the elevator as we seek to improve our service. We apologize in advance for the inconveniences that may happen over the next few months.
